Teachers have compiled the lists below to help guide parents, who may wish to furnish the supplies for their child.

This is not a requirement, but simply a list of suggested supplies.

KINDERGARTEN:

One labeled lunch box
One labeled backpack
(Wheeled backpacks are discouraged)
Two large boxes of Kleenex
One bottle of Purell hand sanitizer (8 oz.)
One large package of baby wipes
One container disinfecting surface wipes
One pair pointed tip scissors for children (**Fiskars softgrip**)
Two boxes (24 count) Crayola crayons
One box snack-size zip lock bags
One box sandwich-size zip lock bags

FIRST GRADE:

Backpacks with shoulder straps
(Wheeled backpacks are discouraged)
One box of Kleenex for classroom use
One box of (10) Crayola Classic fine-tip markers
Three Avery jumbo white glue sticks (1.27 oz)
One Staedtler white eraser
Crayola colored pencils (12-count box)
Crayola crayons (24-count box)
Ticonderoga pencils, two boxes of 12 (number 2)
Baby wipes (two packages)

SECOND GRADE:

Backpacks with shoulder straps
(Wheeled backpacks are discouraged)
One box of (10) Crayola markers
One box of (10) Crayola fine tip markers
One box of (12) Crayola colored pencils
One zipper pocket case for storing supplies (**NO BOXES**)
One pair of good children's scissors (small)
One 12-inch ruler (with centimeters)
Two Staedtler white erasers
Two large glue sticks (UHU brand if possible)
Two black Sharpie markers (one fine point, one extra fine)
Two red ink pens
Two folders with pockets (no prongs)
Two dozen Ticonderoga #2 pencils
One box of tissues
One container disinfecting wipes

THIRD GRADE:

Red Gel pen for editing
Pen-style highlighters (green, pink, and yellow)
One clean sock for erasing individual white board
One set of markers
Crayola Twistables (12 count) colored pencils
Scissors
Dixon Ticonderoga #2 pencils (2 dozen)
One Staedtler white eraser
Six glue sticks (uncolored)

THIRD GRADE (continued):

Two or three white board Dry Erase Markers
(low odor and non toxic - for student use)
Plastic zippered storage case (**no pencil boxes**)
Two boxes of Kleenex for classroom use
One-inch blue Avery 3-ring binder with vinyl sleeve on cover
One package of 5 color-coded subject dividers for 3 ring binder

One dozen #2 pencils, not mechanical
Seven-inch or eight-inch all purpose scissors
Plastic zippered storage cases (**NO PENCIL BOXES**)
Twelve-count box of colored pencils
Small sharpener with lid (for colored pencils)
Eight-count box, Crayola Classic fine-tip markers
Two or three white board Dry Erase Markers (low odor and non toxic - for student use)
One clean sock or an eraser for erasing individual white boards
Box of Kleenex for classroom use
Highlighters (two green, two yellow, and two pink)
Moist baby wipes
Swingline mini stapler (that uses standard staples)
Three black extra fine-point Sharpie permanent markers
1 roll permanent double-sided (Scotch) tape

FIFTH GRADE:

Tabbed dividers (numbered 1-30)
Colored pencils (12-pack)
Five to six 2-pocket folders (one per subject)

Plastic zippered pencil storage case
Extra #2 pencils and erasers
White-out tape
Personal pencil sharpener
Two blue ink pens
Two black ink pens - erasable
Four red ink pens for editing
Two extra fine tip black Sharpie markers
One box of markers (fine tip)
Twelve-inch ruler, calibrated in 1/16 inches
Scissors
Two glue sticks
Mini stapler plus extra staples
Two or three white board Dry Erase Markers (fine tip)
(low odor and non toxic - for student use)
One clean sock for erasing individual white boards
