SCHOOL SUPPLIES LIST 2011 – 2012

Teachers have compiled the lists below to help guide parents, who may wish to furnish the supplies for their child. This is not a requirement, but simply a list of suggested supplies.

KINDERGARTEN:

One labeled lunch box
One labeled backpack
(Wheeled backpacks are discouraged)
One large boxes of Kleenex
One bottle of Purell hand sanitizer (8 oz.)
One large package of baby wipes
One large container of disinfecting surface wipes
One pair pointed-tip scissors for children (**Fiskars soft grip**)
Two boxes (24 count) Crayola crayons
One snack size Ziploc baggies
One large box Q-tips (375 in box)
One box (10 count) Crayola Markers
One (12 count) Ticonderoga Beginners #2 HB pencils

FIRST GRADE:

Backpacks with shoulder straps
(Wheeled backpacks are discouraged)
Two boxes of Kleenex for classroom use
One box of (10) Crayola Classic fine-tip markers
Four Avery jumbo white glue sticks (1.27 oz)
One Staedtler white eraser
Crayola colored pencils (24-count box)
Crayola crayons (24-count box)
Ticonderoga pencils, two boxes of 12 (number 2)
Baby wipes (three packages)

SECOND GRADE:

Backpacks with shoulder straps
(Wheeled backpacks are discouraged)
One box (24) count Crayola Crayons
One box of (10) Crayola markers
One box of (10) Crayola fine tip markers
One box of (12) Crayola colored pencils
One zipper pocket case for storing supplies (**NO BOXES**)
One pair of good children's scissors (small)
One 12-inch ruler (displays both centimeters and inches)
Two Staedtler white erasers
Three large glue sticks (UHU brand if possible)
Two black Sharpie markers (one fine point, one extra fine)
Three red ink pens
Two folders with pockets (no prongs)
Two dozen Ticonderoga #2 pencils
One box of tissues
One container disinfecting wipes or handi-wipes

THIRD GRADE:

Two Uniball Red Gel pens for editing
Pen-style highlighters (green, pink, and yellow)
One clean sock for erasing individual white board
Colored markers (1 set thin point tip) (1 set thick tip)
Crayola Twistables (12 count) colored pencils
Scissors
Dixon Ticonderoga #2 pencils (2 dozen)
One Staedtler white eraser

THIRD GRADE (continued):

Six glue sticks (uncolored)
Crayons (24 count)
Two or three white board Dry Erase Markers
(low odor and non toxic - for student use)
Plastic zippered storage case (**no pencil boxes**)

Three blue or black ink pens
Three red ink pens for editing
One dozen #2 pencils, not mechanical
Seven-inch or eight-inch all purpose scissors
Plastic zippered storage cases (**NO PENCIL BOXES**)
Twenty-Four- count box of colored pencils
Small sharpener with lid (for colored pencils)
Eight-count box, Crayola Classic fine-tip markers
One white board Dry Erase Markers (low odor and non toxic - for student use)
One clean sock or an eraser for erasing individual white boards
Two boxes of Kleenex for classroom use
Highlighters (one green, one yellow, and one pink)
Moist baby wipes (2 boxes unscented)
Swingline mini stapler (that uses standard staples)
Three black extra fine-point Sharpie pens
1 roll permanent double-sided (Scotch) tape with dispenser
4 Large Glue Sticks
1 Correction Tape (not Liquid)

FIFTH GRADE:

Five to six 2-pocket folders (one per subject)
Plastic zippered pencil storage case
Extra #2 pencils and erasers

Personal pencil sharpener
Highlighters (green, yellow and pink)

Four red ink pens for editing
Four extra fine tip black Sharpie markers
One box of markers (fine tip)
Ruler (displays both centimeters and inches /calibrated in 1/16 inches)
Scissors
Two glue sticks
Mini stapler plus extra staples
Four or Five white board Dry Erase Markers (fine tip) (low odor and non toxic - for student use)
Clean sock for erasing individual white boards
Two Boxes of Kleenex for classroom use
Moist baby wipes
Book Covers (3 Jumbo / 1 small)
